

The parties anticipate that a number of these initiatives will occur during the period of this MOU. However, neither party is obligated to agree to any minimum number of activities, nor is the MOU intended to preclude either party from entering into similar agreements with other institutions.

This MOU shall be identified as the parent document of any program agreement executed between the parties. Further agreements concerning any program shall provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing, executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties.

The primary contacts for this MOU are Head of the Department of Political science, H.P.B. Girls' College, Golaghat and Managing Trustee of Borahi Foundation. As previously noted, the parties shall enter into specific written agreements whenever appropriate clarify and define the nature, extent and terms of operation for the proposed collaborations, including intellectual property ownership and funding issues. Any agreement entered into by these two institutions will require the approval of appropriate officers from each institution. 

The **ECONOMIC FORUM** is a constituent body of Hemo Prova Borbora Girls' College, Golaghat which has come out as a voluntary academic body in January, 2001 under the initiative of the Department of Economics with the vision of fostering the goals of the Parent Institution i.e. H.P.B.Girls' College, Golaghat, a leading premier institution of the District of Golaghat, Assam especially for women education. The Prime objective of the Economic Forum is to bring in all round development of the college along with the neighbourhood community. Since the beginning, it has been involved with the diverse socio-economic problems of Greater Golaghat as well as the State of Assam.

The **Economic Forum** has approached **GOLAGHAT FOUNDATION** (**TRUST**) to be a collaborative member of H.P.B.Girls' College, Golaghat to do various social activities and undertaking various socio-economic research based projects works etc. along with the stakeholders of the college fraternity for the development of the college as well as the society as a whole.

After a threadbare discussion between the executive members of both Economic Forum and Golaghat Foundation, both the parties have agreed to execute an MoU (Memorandum of Understanding) and carry out the collaborative works as entered into the MoU as per the terms and conditions set out hereafter.

The MoU witnesses as under-

1. Scope of the MoU

- 1.1 Golaghat Foundation (Trust), Golaghat hereby agrees to become the collaborative institutional member of Economic Forum, H.P.B.Girls' College, Golaghat to work jointly for the progress and development of the institution and the society as a whole involving the stakeholders of the college and the local community of the college.
- 1.2 The H.P.B.Girls' College, Golaghat shall provide the necessary infrastructure within the college campus for doing and undertaking the collaborative works to be done in the field as mentioned in the nature of joint works.
- 1.3 The Faculty members and the college students will undertake socio-economic research based projects and do other social activities where the stakeholders of the Golaghat Foundation would be the collaborative as well as cooperative members hand-to-hand. Similarly, the stakeholders of Economic Forum would also be collaborative and co-operative friend with the works to be undertaken by the Golaghat Foundation.
- **2.**Upon execution of this MoU, the Economic Forum and Golaghat Foundation shall communicate to each and other for their joint works. The reupon, the parties shall mutually discuss and agree on the operational terms based on which both the voluntary body will work together.

3. Validity

- 7.1: Undertaking, co-ordinating, promoting, collaborating the extension works and socio-economic activities and other relevant current issues with an emphasis on our local region/area of the country.
- 7.2: Providing a common platform for social interaction and exchange of positive ideas, thoughts and research experiences for the benefit of our human society.
- 7.3: contributing towards the promotion of a congenial atmosphere conducive to socio-economic research and produce practical and meaningful solution of the problems addressed or undertaken by the Forum.
- 7.4: Involving faculty members and students in the development process of different community and fostering social change through meaningful relation and interaction through the establishment of a necessary linkage with reputed institutions.
- 7.5: Increasing effective participation of students in different academic programmes and development processes.

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- 7.6: Advancing higher education access among the outreached, backward or deprived students providing an opportunity to sensitize themselves with contemporary problems and realities by means of orientation, counselling or exposure through field based activities.

About the Institution

Beneath the cloud-capped hills, amidst luxuriant woodlands and surrounded by the shimmering waters of the Umiam Lake, lays an idyllic conclave of houses and buildings that make up one of the unique Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) in the North Eastern Region - the Union Christian College, popularly known by its acronym, UCC. Jutting out into the Umiam Lake like a mini-peninsula, the sprawling campus of the UCC sported tree-lined avenues, hedges of forget-me-nots, patches of greenery and quiet roofs beneath huge stately trees whose leaves flutter incessantly in the caresses of the gentle breeze. It was as quiet and tranquil as one wishes it to be an ideal setting for young minds to gather precious gems of knowledge.

However, the place was once a wild land, stuck in timelessness, until a seed for its destiny was sown by the high ideals of its founding fathers. It was after a long awaited effort the beginning of the College saw the light of day on Friday, the **14**th **August, 1952**, the day which the College celebrates as its foundation day every year.

Today, Union Christian College is a "minuscule North East" embracing a diverse and complex multi- cultural ethos where ideals, perceptions and aspirations vary. Sixty-seven years hence, the College is steadily progressing and growing from day to day. From a little acorn, it is now a towering oak, making steadfast progress on all fronts living up to its motto 'Come to the living water' quenching the thrst of all those who had come to seek wisdom and knowledge within its hallowed grounds.

The College is located in Rural-Tribal backward area, under Umsning C.&.R.D. Block of Ri-Bhoi District of Meghalaya, with a geographical area of 170.2 acres and an approximate built-up area of 60.2 acres. It is the only under-graduate Residential Institution under 2(F) 12(B) UGC Act 1956, in the District offering three Under-Graduate programmes in Arts, Science and Commerce. Currently the Institution has 63 teaching faculty staff with an enrollment of 935 students during the academic session 2017-18, with 533 males (57 per cent) and 402 females (43 per cent) students. Students hailing from all the eight North-Eastern states are being catered in the institution, where during the same academic session 2019-20, 310 (31 %), 200 (20 %), 140 (14%), 144 (14 %), 118 (12 %), 42 (4 %), 22 (2 %) and 1 (0.1 %) students are from Arunachal Pradesh, Tripura, Mizoram, Assam, Meghalaya, Manipur, Nagaland and Sikkim


respectively. Out of the total students enrolled, 954 (96 %) belong to the Scheduled Tribe category, of which 528 (55%) are male and 426 (45 %) female students respectively. Majority of the students enrolled in the Institution belong to the most economically impoverished and marginalized group - Scheduled Tribe Category (95%), followed by students belonging to General (3 %), SC (0.32%) and OBC (1.82) categories respectively.



Pathak, Director of Extension Education (DEE), AAU, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors · in office and assigns, hereinafter called as the "Second Party". To impart both theoretical and hands-on training for Self-financed Certificate Courses to the students of Hem Prova Borbora Girls' College under the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The First Party, through its Political Science Department, proposes to organise Addon Courses on Poly-house and Protective Cultivation for the students of the institution with the Second Party's technical assistance.
- 2. The Second Party agrees to impart both theoretical and hands-on training to the students of the institution for the Add-on/Certificate Courses.
- 3. The First Party will provide its infrastructural facilities and their logistics as and when required for training to be used by the second party for these courses.

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- 4. The Second Party agrees to provide faculties for both theoretical and hands-on trainings. However, the faculties will conduct the classes as per their conveniences without hampering the mandated activities. The First Party may also provide faculty for any assistance if required by the Second Party.
- 5. The Second Party may decide to impart training to the students in their campus as and when they deem fit as per requirement of the courses.
- 6. The First Party agrees to bear the travelling expenses and honorarium of the faculty and other expenses that may be necessary for conducting the course.
- 7. Both the parties agree to work out the time-table of the courses without hampering the regular class routines.
- 8. The First Party will be responsible for all the academic matters relating to the course and necessary guidance and support may be taken from the Second Party as and when required.
- 9. The First Party agrees to issue Course Completion Certificates to the students wherein the Second Party will also be a signatory.
