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





A one day workshop on "Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) was organized by IQAC, H. P. B Girls' College, Golaghat on 24th March, 2021. The workshop identified the B.A undergraduate students who are presently pursuing different courses in the college as its focal audience. Nevertheless, the session was equally attended by many faculty members as well. The workshop began at the Multi-purpose classroom with the introductory remarks delivered by Assistant Professor Sumit Kumar Sarma. The welcome address delivered by the Principal of the college, Dr. Bipul Ch. Bhuyan. In his welcome speech, Dr. Bhuyan, introduces the resource person for the day, Dr. Palash Handique who himself is an Assistant Prof. in the Department of Economics of the same college, and holds a LL.B degree as well. Dr. Handique is also the current IQAC Coordinator of the college. Congratulating all the participating students and the faculty members, Dr Bhuyan in his engrossing speech highlights the relevance of the concerned workshop in the present day academic sphere. He eloquently informs the students about the inception and the history of the expansion of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) across the globe. Dr. Bhuyan further throws some light on the different types of IPR such as: Copyrights, Patents, Trademarks and Trade Secrets. Dr. Bhuyan expressed his optimism that such a workshop would greatly benefit all the students in carrying out their respective academic research works while ensuring optimum commitment to various research ethics. Thus extending his goodwill to all the participants, he invited Dr. Handique to deliver his presentation on the concerned theme of the workshop.

At the very onset of his talk which was duly aided by an informative power point presentation, Dr. Handique re-iterates the strong commitment pronounced by both UGC and NAAC to ensure adequate "utilization of human resources in the Institute of Higher Education(IHE)" across the nation. He further states that in today's world IPR has become almost indispensible to deter any form of illegal infringement of copyrights, violation of product patents or unjust use of authorized trademarks. Through his engaging talk, Dr. Handique elaborated about the various historic past events that paved the way for the inception of IPR, and also discussed the global conventions (with special reference to Paris Convention1883 & Berne Convention 1886), the major Acts, and the statutory role of WIPO which had led to the institution of the legal framework of IPR. He also informed the participants

about the strategic goals and the core tasks of WIPO, and also highlighted the minimum standards approved by The Agreement on Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights,1995 (TRIPS) for the availability of , scope , and use of seven forms of Intellectual property. These are: copyrights, trademarks, geographical indications, industrial designs, patents, patents layout designs for integrated circuits, and undisclosed information(trade secrets). He further drew the attention towards various legal recourses under IPC concerning enforcement procedures, dispute settlements and available legal remedies. While concluding his talk, Dr. Handique earnestly appealed to all the participating students to be informed and judicious with regard to the aspects of IPR. He further urged everyone to uphold the ethical code of conduct while committing oneself to any academic research in the near future. This was followed by a brief Q&A session in which both the participating students and the faculty members had communicated their queries to the resource person. Thus the entire Q&A session translated into quite a productive discussion on IPR. The workshop came to a befitting conclusion with the vote of thanks speech delivered by Assist. Prof. Sumit Sarma.







The FDP was initiated with theopening remarksdelivered by the IQAC Co-ordinator, Dr. Palash Handique. In his brief remark, Dr. Handique extended his warm greetings tothe distinguished resource person from Pune, Maharastra, Dr. N. S. Dharmadhikari, an eminent educationist & NationalAssessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) Peer Team member, and welcomed all the participating faculty members of the college. The session was formally inaugurated with abrief address from the Hon'ble Principal of the college, Dr. Bipul Ch. Bhuyan. In his short speech, Dr. Bhuyan emphasized upon the importance of hosting such faculty development programme to ensure qualitative and quantitative improvement of educational environment.

Speaking at the session, Dr. Dharmadhikari commended the effort of the organizers for hosting this particular FDP at the college. He also added that such events are often deemed to be important when it comes to the submission of Self Study Report of a college due for NAAC assessment.

Dr. Dharmadhikari further underlined the importance of what he calls 'C³ and D³' with regard to performing better in NAAC assessment. With regard to specific collaborations, he added, an institute may offer coaching classes for various competitive examinations, skill/ability enhancement courses by signing MOUs with various competent agencies and faculty exchange programmes as well. Concerning the need for reaching out to its diverse neighbourhood community, the concerned Departments of the college should focus on bio/ethnic/linguistic diversity of a region. He urged the Department Heads to conduct subject orientated awareness drives among local communities and capacity building courses for the students.


