## Principal's Desk



The College has had its moments of challenges and rejoice during the stated period. The first challenge appeared in the form of the submission of Self-Study Report (SSR) for the 3<sup>rd</sup> cycle (supposed to submit in 2017) of NAAC assessment after ten years of the 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle (2012). The preparation and submission posed a challenge as the 3<sup>rd</sup> cycle report imposed additional conditions and requirements than the 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle which tested the collective will of the College.

The second challenge relating to NAAC assessment appeared in the form of facing the NAAC peer team. Insufficient funds hindered the completion of critical construction projects. This was overcome through the generous financial assistance of some well-wishers of the College situated within Golaghat District.

The trials and tribulations faced during the process of NAAC assessment also provided moments of rejoice. The College submitted its SSR on 13<sup>th</sup> January 2022. On the basis of the SSR, the NAAC peer team visited the College on 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. And in its 110<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Standing Committee, the College has been accredited with an **A Grade (3.20 CGPA)** This was a blissful experience for all the stakeholders of the College.

The third challenge appeared in the form of celebration of the closing ceremony of its Golden Jubilee in 2020 which was postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The challenge pertained to raising of funds within a short period of time. After overcoming this challenge, the College celebrated the closing ceremony of the Golden Jubilee on 27th, 28th and 29th October 2022. This was another moment of rejoice for the college fraternity. On behalf of the college fraternity, I offer my sincere thanks to all the well-wishers of the college, including Golaghat district administration and all those who contributed in various ways for the successful execution of the programme.

The Government of India is going to implement the New Education Policy (NEP), 2020 in the country. Implementation of the NEP would pose numerous challenges for the College which has a single stream. The H.P.B. Girls' College has been preparing to face the challenge of executing the NEP with its limited resources.

#### **Editorial**

Autonomy to Colleges: The Good and the Bad

Autonomy to colleges implies a functional status whereby the University Grants Commission (UGC) empower Colleges to undertake autonomous steps both in curricular and noncurricular areas for improving the academic standards of their institution. Significant importance has been given to the concept of autonomy in the New Education Policy (NEP), 2020. On the brighter side NEP, 2020, promotes creativity by enabling colleges and faculties to innovate on matters of curriculum, pedagogy, and assessment within a broad framework of higher education qualifications that ensures consistency across institutions and programmes.

However, the system also have its demerits: a) majority of colleges in India are affiliating colleges, which are completely free from the responsibility of developing and implementing institutional rules and academic regulations like academic timetables, classes, framing of syllabus, review, conduct of assessment and evaluation, which is at present carried out by the concerned affiliating universities; b) after attaining autonomous status, colleges have to take additional burden and responsibility which necessitates more responsible, professional and trained personnel which are not sufficiently provided by concerned authority; c) there may be a lack of standardised and uniform syllabus, pedagogy and methods of assessment, and evaluation in the country if all colleges will be given academic freedom; d) further, there may be lack of integrity, honesty and unbiasedness among the colleges with regards to creating good image (?) in the society. If it happens, the objective of granting autonomy to colleges will be thwarted.

The NEP, 2020 is targeting all affiliated colleges becoming either an autonomous college or constituent college of the University in the next fifteen years that needs effective strategies

The NAAC peer team visited in the college on 7th and 8th June 2022. **Dr. Dharmarajan P K, Dr. Parveen Akhter Pandit** and **Dr. Sangeeta Ghate** visited in the college as the Chairperson, the Member Coordinator and the Member of the team respectively. The college has been accredited **A Grade (3.20 CGPA)** in the 110th Meeting of the Standing Committee held on 14th June, 2022 of the NAAC.


