# Editorial

The National Education Policy-2020 (NEP-2020) articulates well on how the entire system of education can be organised and implemented at various levels such that the quality standard is enhanced, the quality of student learning experiences increases and the employability and quality of the graduates is strengthened. It is a comprehensive reform that aims to transform India's education system. NEP-2020 advocates for all the higher education institutions to moving towards 'blended' teaching-learning by combining self-learning, face-to-face interaction, and online collaborative learning along with combining traditional classroom education, distance learning, and online learning. While the entire higher education is going to practice blended learning, the educational resources need not confine to the textbooks only. The students can access open educational resources (OERs), social networks, YouTube resources, and the digital resources available through various national and regional networks in the country including SWAYAM, NPTEL and other MOOC platforms, etc. Holistic but flexible curriculum components of NEP 2020 includes i) Multidisciplinary & holistic education; ii) Skilling & employability; iii) Indian language, culture & art; iv) Environment & value-based education; v) Research and internships; vi) Community engagement and service; vii) Multiple entry & exit; viii) Industry-academia linkages and ix) Integration of STEAM. These core components specify integration of multidisciplinary and multiple entry and exit in the curricular structure and integration of arts education with the STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics education, to make it STEAM). To enhance employability, multidisciplinary courses and skill-based courses need to be offered. Courses on values, environment, community engagement, social and life skills etc will not only enhance employability but also will contribute to holistic, integrated and balanced as well as happy life.

Studies on education, teaching, and learning recommend a systematic way of knowledge production and management. They highlight the importance of suitable learning environments, which are essential for proper incubation of knowledge, facilitating and promoting the free and fair exercise of knowledge creation. With the shift towards a more flexible knowledge system, the demand is for a paradigmatic shift towards a faster, innovation-centric, knowledge-intensive, and knowledge-harnessing ecosystem. It means that the education sectors need to gear up for a significant overhaul and break away from its rigid industrial modus-operandi. Moreover, in the journey for academic excellence, the initiatives of NEP 2020 will surely become milestones in the coming days. Keeping with the spirit of NEP, H. P. B. Girls' College, Golaghat has taken all possible steps to implement all required guidelines of the National Education Policy 2020.
